

WAR MEMORIAL AT LIVERPOOL, UNVEILED
ON SATURDAY.



The memorial was erected by the townspeople in memory of Private A. E. Smith, son of ex-Police Sergeant Smith, who died of fever while on active service. It was unveiled in the presence of about 1000 persons, and consists of a trachyte monument surmounted by a lamp, gratuitously designed by Mr. John Ball, Customs and Excise Officer.
