This soldier, who was a son of Mr. and Mrs. H. T. Cook, of Major's Creek, was killed in the fighting in France on 7th June, 1917. He enlisted on the 26th September, 1916, and sailed from Sydney on the 25th November of the same year. He was attached to the 45th Battalion. A fine type of Australian, he was extremely popular on the Creek and throughout the district. He was 22 years of age when "The Last Post" sounded.
