

ABORIGINAL MEMORIAL.

The Memorial erected by the Rangers' League in New South Wales in the old Camperdown Cemetery in memory of certain Aborigines buried there nearly a century ago. The Memorial was originally in the old Balmain Cemetery and converted to its present use when this cemetery was closed and a number of old memorials were unclaimed by any of the descendants. The word is as follows:
