NEW PUBLIC LIBRARY.

Striking Features of Building.

The new public library in Macquarie Street will contain the largest marble mosaic floor which has been put down in any building in Australia. The design is a replica of the Tasman Map, which is one of the treasures of the Mitchell Library.

Another interesting feature of the new building will be a stained-glass window. presented by "The Sydney Morning Herald" to mark the five-hundredth anniversary of the invention of printing.
