

NINNES DISTRICT COUNCIL

The first meeting of the above Council was held on Saturday, 19th July, when there were present— Messrs H. D. O'Halloran, W. H. Patterson, G. F. Mills, W. H. Stephens, and G. F. Ormsby.

The *Gazette* notice was read, proclaiming the Hundred under a District Council, with the above gentlemen as first councillors.

Mr H. D. O'Halloran was unanimously elected chairman.

It was resolved that the National Bank, Kadina, be the Council's Bank.

PLAN OF THE DISTRICT.

It was decided that Mr Beresford be instructed to prepare a plan of the District for the use of the Council.

CLERK AND OVERSEER.

It was resolved to insert a notice in the *Walloo Times* calling applications from persons willing to undertake the position of Clerk and Overseer for the Council.

Mrs Ormsby, the postmistress, was temporarily appointed registrar of dogs.

It was also decided that the Council meet on the third Saturday of each month.

The Chairman was empowered to arrange for making the first assessment for the District.

A letter was received from Mr Daniel, asking that the boundary road between Ninnes and Kulpara might be cleared. Received,
