

THE LATE MR. WILLIAM POPE.

£6,200 to St. Peter's Cathedral.

Application has been made by Mr. T. R. Mellor, and the Executor Trustee and Agency Company of South Australia (two of the executors) for probate of the will of the late Mr. William Pope, of Mount House, Strangways terrace, North Adelaide. The gross estate is estimated at £160,000. The testator made large charitable requests, amounting to £9,150, including the following gifts:—

£2,000 to establish a St. Peter's Cathedral Choir Fund, to be called the Pope Endowment Choir Fund.

£2,000 as an endowment, to be called the Pope Special Preachers' Fund, the income to be used for obtaining the best preachers for the cathedral.

£1,200 to the Bishop of Adelaide and wardens of St. Peter's Cathedral, for the purpose of placing a suitable stained glass window in the largest west window of the nave of St. Peter's Cathedral.

£1,000 as an Endowment Fund for the Bishop's Home Mission Fund Society; the income to be applied for the benefit of such society.

£200 to the Boys' Brigade, Adelaide.

£500 to the Queen's Home, Adelaide.

£250 to the Lady Victoria Buxton Girls' Club.

£250 to the St. Mary's Mission of Hope, Halifax street, Adelaide.

£500 to the Children's Hospital, North Adelaide.

£500 to the Home for Invalids, Fullarton.

The late Mr. Pope also left liberal legacies to his employes and office staff, some of whom had been with him for many years.
