DEDICATION OF THE HONOUR ROLL.

The service at the Presbyterian Church on Sunday morning, the occasion of the dedication of the Honour Roll, was one that will long be remembered by those who witnessed the solemn ceremony. The congregation was probably the largest that has yet assembled in the sacred edifice. Relatives of the soldiers were directed to the front seats, a few returned men also being present. The Rev. R. Scott-West of Barwood, formerly Moderator of the N.S.W. Assembly, delivered the sermon and dedicated the Honor Roll, Rev. A. C. Grieve (Bingara) Moderator of the Moree Presbytery, and Rev. Graham Hughes assisting in the service. Mrs. Grieve presided at the organ, the choir having been arranged for the occasion by Mr. Hazeltine. The text of the sermon was the 5th verse of the 20th Psalm, "We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners." The preacher during the interesting discourse spoke in forcible terms on various phases of the war, including the "New Australia." In the dedication of the Honor Roll the unveiling was effected by Mrs. D. Mackay.

The Honor Roll is made of pure white Sicilian marble as the base, with pediment and columns of Australian colored marble, relieved by bands of Mexican Onyx, the head portion being triangular and made of the same marble, and in the inset appears the following: "The Great War 1914.—The Men who Fought." The following names (incised lettering, gold filled) are on the Roll:—
