


TRINITY COLLEGE HORSFALL CHAPEL WORLD WAR ONE HONOUR ROLL BOARD

The Horsfall Chapel at Trinity Chapel was designed by Alexander North in the Arts & Crafts style and was completed in 1917, with most of its stained glass windows either collectively or individually dedicated to its World War One alumni.
