

Bahgallah Honor Roll.

To Be Unveiled Saturday.

Some months ago a movement was started at Bahgallah (as reported in the "Free Press" at the time) to have prepared an Honor Roll of State School scholars and district residents who had volunteered for the war, and the donations to the fund were so free and liberal that the committee having charge of affairs found itself in a position to afford a name board, designed and executed on a more than ordinarily elaborate scale. At a meeting held to discuss the class of board that would best meet the case and to decide where it should be hung, it was partly agreed that the names on the Honor Roll should be painted on, but after going into the matter of price with a local tradesman, it was decided by the committee that metal lettering on the board would be more permanent than painted names, while an artistic result, combined with a monetary saving, could also be assured in this way. Accordingly the wording was supplied to a Melbourne firm which specialises in beaten copper art work, and the names of the soldiers whom it was intended to honor in this way were hammered into the solid metal and shown on the face in embossed form, while a similar process was adopted in respect to the other wording, as given below.

To Mr E. G. Baker, art furnisher of this town, was entrusted the task of completing the board, utilising the lettering referred to. The general effect is most gratifying, the work being, in every respect, a credit to the committee and a fitting coping to its high-minded and patriotic undertaking. The Board is of black-wood, with fiddle back panels, and the ornamentation in woodwork consists of pillars, an elliptic top and crossed rifles, with wattle leaves and blossoms as a background.
