

#### Monument to Father Corcoran.

A meeting of the congregation of St. Monica's Church was held in the school room on Sunday morning. Mr J. Lyons, M.L.A., was voted to the chair, and said the object of the meeting was to do something to commemorate the memory of the late Father Corcoran. It was proposed, he said, to erect a monument in the cemetery to his memory. It was decided that all present form a committee, and that an executive committee, consisting of seven, besides the chairman, the treasurer, and the secretary be formed. On the motion of Mr F. Brown, the seven appointed were the Rev. Fathers Doyle and O'Keefe, Messrs C. Walsh, W. Lennon, J. Collins, J. Keating, M. Ward, R. Walsh, and the mover. Mr Lyons was appointed chairman Mr W. T. Francis secretary, and Father Doyle treasurer. It was resolved that the ladies of the parish be asked to call a meeting and form themselves into a committee to assist in getting subscriptions. A collection was taken up in the room, and \$14 7s donated or promised. It was agreed that the executive committee meet on Thursday at 8 p.m. A vote of thanks to the chairman concluded the meeting. Father Doyle intends holding a meeting for the same purpose at Mareeba and Port Douglas at an early date. Father O'Keefe, of Herberton, has kindly undertaken to do all he can in his district.
