

Honor Roll Unveiled.

AT WONTHAGGI CLUB.

The honor roll of the Wonthaggi Club, which is a list of the members, sons of members, and ex-members, who have served in the Australian Imperial, and Imperial Forces, was unveiled by Captain S. M. Bruce, M.C., M.H.R. for Flinders, yesterday, in the presence of many club members, their friends, and a number of returned soldiers.

The Vice - President, Mr. P. H. Conant, in the unavoidable absence of the President (Dr. Sleeman) presided.

Capt. Bruce spoke in sincere terms of the work of the Australian soldiers, and the duties and obligations of those who were ineligible for active service. All could assist by creating a National spirit. He paid a high tribute to those whose names were inscribed on the Honor Roll, which was dedicated in memory of those who had realised their duty in the crisis of the Nation. It would be an inspiration to future generations.

Senator Lieut-Col. Bolton also spoke, and said that some of the finest soldiers came from Wonthaggi.

A vote of thanks, moved by Mr. Colin Campbell, was carried by acclamation, and proceedings closed with the singing of the National Anthem.
