

PROPOSED OBELISK.

Sketch of the proposed Sinclair Memorial Obelisk to be erected on the Esplanade at Bowen, to commemorate the discovery of Port Denison on 16th October, 1850 by Henry Daniel Sinclair, James Gordon, Benjamin Poole and W. H. Thomas in the "Santa Barbara" and the settlement of Bowen on 12th April, 1861 by 111 persons under George Elphinstone Dalrymple, Government Representative. The sketch is the work of Mr. H. D. Hawkins, Bowen Town Council Foreman. A Committee has been formed to raise funds for the erection and it is hoped to have same completed by the date of this year's anniversary.
