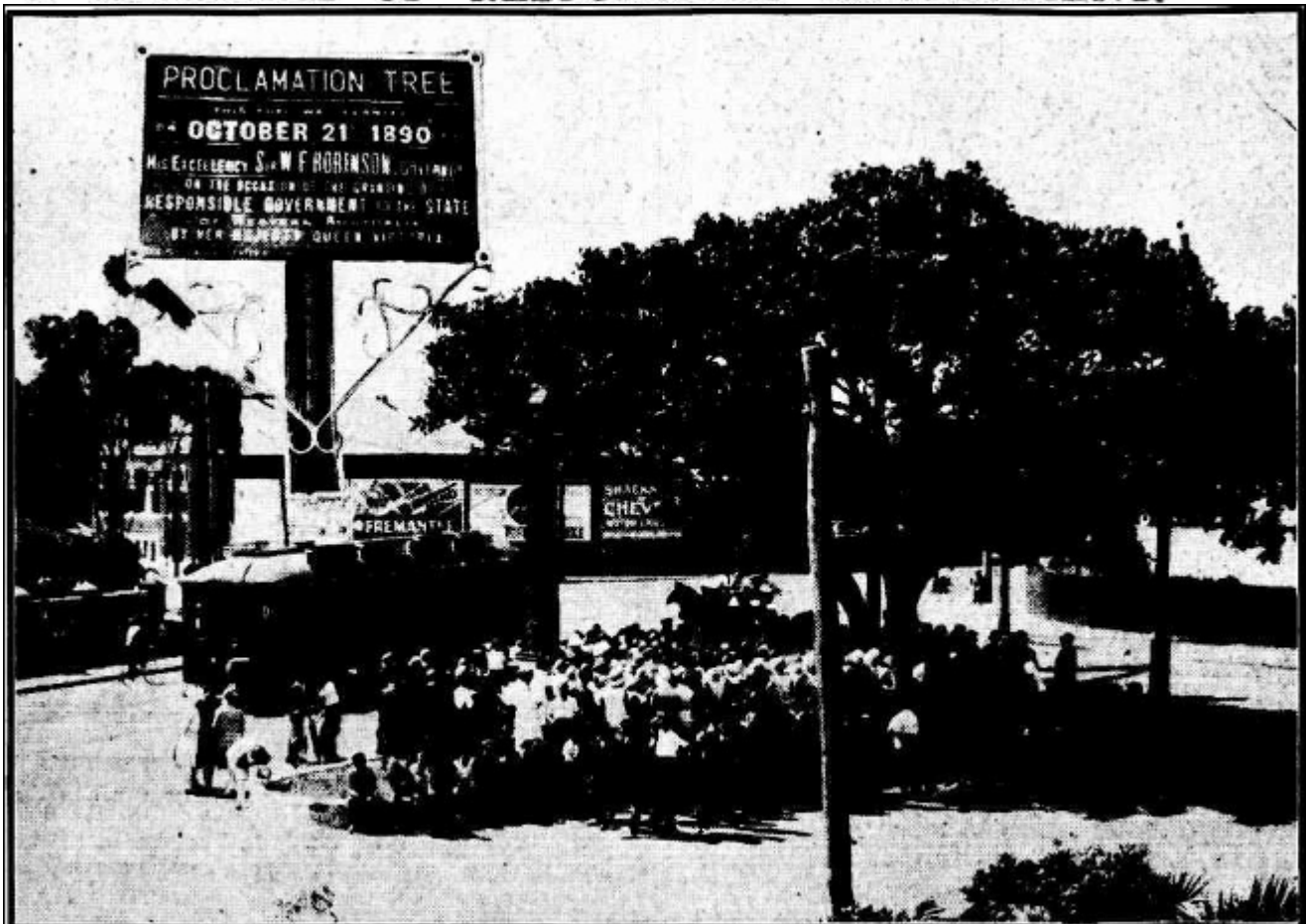


A MEMORIAL OF RESPONSIBLE GOVERNMENT.



Yesterday afternoon a tablet, provided by scholars of the Fremantle Boys' School, was unveiled by the Mayor of Fremantle (Mr. F. E. Gibson) near a Moreton Bay fig tree which was planted in 1890 to celebrate the granting of responsible government to Western Australia. The tree is in what was known as Mayer's Park, Fremantle.
