Zeal and Generosity in Yorketown Parish £4,900 Subscribed to Establish Convent School

as War Memorial

At a well attended and representative meeting of the parishioners of the Yorketown Parish, held in Yorketown under the chairmanship of Mr. J. F. Honner, on July 10, 1949, it was decided to establish a Convent School in Yorketown as a memorial to parishioners who served in World Wars I and/or II. Since then £4,911/2/- has been subscribed by parishioners.

The resolutions passed at the July meeting were:

- That the parishioners of the Yorketown Parish cause a War Memorial to be erected and maintained to the memory of those members of the parish who served in the fighting forces during either, or both, the 1914-18 and/or the 1939-45 World Wars.
- That such a War Memorial shall be a public memorial, and shall take the form of a convent school, to be established at Yorketown.
- That a public appeal be conducted and a public subscription list be opened, in order to establish a public fund for the erection and establishment of the said Memorial.
- That the said Fund be administered by and under the control of an executive committee.

PROVISION FOR BOARDERS

The appointees to the executive committee were as follows:—

Father J. O'Callaghan, P.P., Mr. J. F. Honner (chairman), Mr. R. D. Feehan (vice-chairman), Mr F. W. Jones (treasurer), Mr. H. A. Jones, and Mr. G. A. Mahar (joint secretaries).

It is intended that the Convent shall make provision for boarders and supply a need of the Yorketown parish, which embraces all the towns and districts of Central and Southern Yorke Peninsula.

Donations of £1 and over will entitle donors to the concessional allowtitle donors to the concessional allowances permitted by Sections 78 and 160 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1936-1948. Official receipts will be forwarded by the honorary secretary (Mr. H. A. Jones), Yorketown, S.A.
