OBITUARY.

MR. J. G. ATLEE HUNT.

The death occurred yesterday of Alderman John Grahame Atlee Hunt, who had been prominently associated with public welfare movements in North Sydney during the last 26 years.



Mr. Hunt was born at Gurley Station, Narrabri, and was educated at East Maitland and Brisbane Grammar School. He entered the service of the Queensland National Bank in Brisbane, and after 12 years' service tesigned to take up a commercial career in Sydney. For more than 20 years he had been associated with the firm of Sayers, Allport Proprietary, Limited. He had been an aiderman of North Sydney Council for six years, and was recently nominated by a meeting of rate-payers for a further term.

Alderman Atlee Hunt was president of the Neutral Bay Public School committee, the Sydney Literary Institute, the Cammeray Boy Scouts and Cricket Club, and of the Cremorne Club. Mrs. Atlee Hunt, Mr. Grahame Hunt (son), and Miss Phylis Hunt (daughter) survive him. The funeral will leave his residence this afternoon for the Northern Suburbs Cemetery.
