

DUMARESQ HONOUR ROLL

Unveiled At Ceremony On Saturday

TRIBUTE TO MEN WHO SERVED

An honour roll bearing the names of men and women who volunteered in the recent war was unveiled at Dumaresq Hall on Saturday night.

The function was attended by representatives of the Armidale sub-branch of the RSL and 150 guests.

Inscribed with sixty names of those who volunteered from the district the tabloid was unveiled by the President of the Dumaresq Shire Council, Mr. J. T. Elliott.

Welcoming Mr. T. Elliott and RSL representatives, Messrs. A. Williams and F. Lawrence, Mr. A. S. Cameron, president of Dumaresq Soldiers' Welcome Home Association, stated that the committee was formed in June, 1940, and the district it covered extended to Boorolong, nearly to Yarrawick and to within three miles of Armidale. Every

three miles of Armidale. Every serviceman from this area had been given a send-off and a "welcome home".

He said that £100 had been collected for the honour roll, and after the erection of the board a surplus of £17 was in hand. This would be handed to Legacy.

Mr. J. T. Elliott thanked the Association for their invitation to him and said he felt privileged to perform the ceremony.

On behalf of ex-servicemen, Mr. Williams thanked the Dumaresq and Boorolong Welfare Society for their efforts in having the board erected. Out of the sixty enlistments, he said, one did not return. A minute's silence was observed in honour of C. L. Pearson, who was killed in action.

Unveiling the honour roll, Mr. Elliott said that while he rejoiced in the home-coming of the ex-servicemen, he felt the deepest reverence and respect for the man who did not return.
